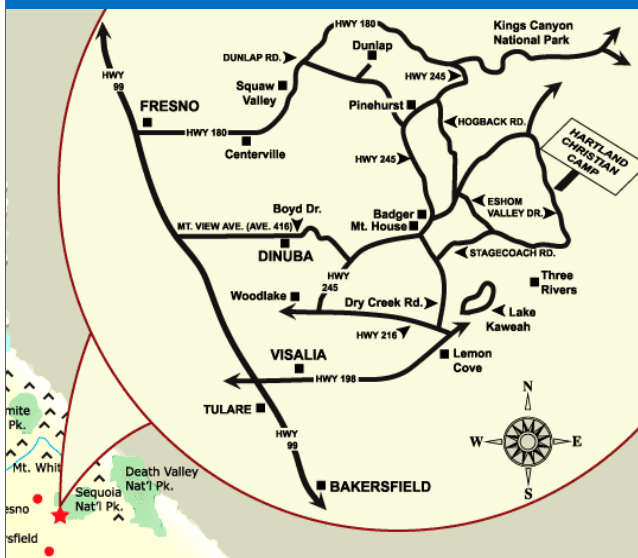

Take 99 south, go east on Hwy. 198 to Lemon Cove. Turn left at Hwy. 216 (Gas station on southwest corner) and go 1/2 mile to Dry Creek Road (J21). Turn right on Dry Creek Road. Go approximately 16 miles. Turn right at the "Y" onto Stagecoach. Stagecoach will end at Eshom Valley Road. Turn right onto Eshom Valley Drive and follow to Hartland.
